SUMMARY OF AIRCRAFT ORDERS AT FARNBOROUGH AIR SHOW

Farnborough International Limited reported that the value of the order announcements at the latest show, held on 17-23 July 2006, totals to approximately \$42 billion. Airbus announced the sale of 156 aircraft compared to 72 aircraft orders for Boeing and the remaining 3 aircraft orders announced for Bombardier. The announced orders at the show are detailed below:
